

Hint: many MN Masons know him very well..

This WB was appointed as Senior Deacon by Wm Roger Iverson and was elected Lodge Master in 1997 and again in 2004-2005. He was recommended for Masonic membership by WB Mark Campbell and initiated as an EA 1 Mar 1993, passed to Fellow Craft in Apr and raised a Master on 3 May 1993 in Richfield Lodge #334 and that very fall he was continuing his Masonic Journey for LIGHT at the Minneapolis Valley of the Scottish Rite, and in Dec received the 32*. In Oct of 2001 he was awarded the rank and decoration of the Knight Commander of the Court of Honor. Also in 2001 under the direction of WM Lee Wiech, the Lodge presented him with the Hiram award. He served as a member of Zuhrah Shrine and (RAM) Royal Arch Chapter #1, Richfield Chapter (OES) Order of the eastern Star #293 and the MN National soiourners #25

Lakewood Cemetery Cataract Lodge Masonic Burial Site

The site was purchased on 17 Apr 1885 at a cost of \$650 when Charles D Boyce was Cataract Lodge #2 Master: 27 burial sites were involved in this purchase-- that was at a cost of about \$24 each. This site was numbered #251 Section 6 and has now become known as The Masonic Site. When purchased the contract stated that horses were not to be driven on the grass or left without a driver, except when hitched to posts provided for that purpose.

For some reason the 1st burial in this area of the Cataract Lodge area was for Brother Alden J. Nason on 3 March 1885 about 6 weeks before the lodge officially purchased this site. Bro Nason was born about 1827 in Maine. He was raised as a Master Mason on 5 Mar 1870 at Cataract Lodge and his occupation was listed as 'Lumber Man' and numbered as #298 in Cat#2 records. One Past Master of Cataract Lodge was buried in this block of sites. WB Clinton S. Hull was Master of Cataract Lodge in 1924.

There is a huge Masonic Monument in a very nearby area, which was originally purchased on 27 Jan 1881; by Minneapolis Lodge #19, Hennepin Lodge #4, Royal Arch Chapter #9 and The Zion Commandery #2 Knights Templar. Records indicate that the cremains of Bro. Claude F. Puffer were scattered over lot 234, section 4, grave 70. This was the burial site near the Masonic Monument and his wife had been buried there in 1942. Bro Claude died in 1992. The scattering of

cremated ashes was approved by the Lakewood Cemetery Association A bit of history....

Lakewood Cemetery was created in 1871 as a community trust, Within its borders is 250 acres set between Lake Calhoun and Lake Harriet. In Find a Grave.com about 153,500 sites have been recorded with a mere 16 % having photos of the markers, Lakewood cemetery reports that the capacity is for better than 250,000 so it is a long way from being filled as of 2015. Records are computerized and can be easily searched at www.lakewoodcemetery.com. The cemetery does not allow tree removal unless the tree dies. A dead or dying tree may open up additional burial sites.

Perhaps a visit to this area of Lakewood Cemetery should be planned for Apr 17, 2015, as this site was purchased on 17 Apr 1885, the 130 year anniversary.
