


The Pledge of Allegiance on June 6, Anniversary of D-Day



Who Is Who At Cataract Lodge #2 (3 Generations): Emanuel Friedman

Dec. 14, 1908 — Sep. 16, 1966

Brother Manny, as friends called him, was said to be a dedicated individual who exerted maximum effort during his many endeavors. His motto was " Never walk when you can run." He was initiated, passed and raised as a Master Mason in Sep/Oct 1958 and served as Cataract Lodge Master in 1964. He took the royal Arch degrees in St Anthoney Falls chapter 18 Mar 1963 and in Adoniram Council 5 Dec 1964, and served for a time as Editor of the Cataract News and was also active in degree work at the Scottish Rite Temple as well being known as a real work horse at many performances during Shrine Circus events; Both he and his wife, June, were active in the order of the Eastern Star and June was active in providing meals at Cataract Lodge.. For many years Brother Manny served as Scoutmaster. He enjoyed golf and fishing somewhat less than kissing his grandchildren. On the evening preceding his death he and June entertained his children and family at a dinner party at his home. he was surrounded by the family which he loved ever so dearly, it was said that he kissed each of his 10 grandchildren goodnight, after a pleasant evening and went to see his Maker on 16 Sep 1966 en route to Mt Sinia Hospital after suffering a massive heart attack. On 18 Sep 1966: Members of Cataract lodge, all close friends and associates acted as pallbearers included, Sherman Masler, Nathan Chesler, Edward Schwartz, Charles Lerner, Bernard Goldstein, Vince Berna and Mickey Segal . Services were held at Adath Jeshuran Synagogue with Rabbi Arnold Goodman officiating and internment followed at Adath Jeshuran Cemetery.
