Memorial Day 2018 At Ft. Snelling



Once again, another inspiring program was held at the Fort Snelling National Cemetery to honor those who gave their lives for our country. In spite of the heat, about 2,000 people were in attendance. Several distinguished guests were there to speak and give their thoughts on what Memorial Day means to them. Among them were Governor Mark Dayton, Senators Amy Klobuchar and Tina Smith, Congressman Timothy Walz, as well as several folks representing various Veteran Administration branches, and other veteran and public service groups. An inspiring address was given by Brigadier General Jon Safstrom, Assistant Adjutant General of the MN Air National Guard. A Navy pilot for 10 years before joining the Minnesota Air Guard in 1998, he has over 3,700 flight hours, 300 of them in combat. Several musical interludes were provided by 34th Infantry Division "Red Bull" Band. Two days prior to Memorial Day, 5,000 volunteers were on hand to place flags on every marker in the cemetery.

Once again, as he has for several years now, our own WB Bob Selden was Master of Ceremony. Kudos to him for all the work and organizing he does to make this program a wonderful event year after year. —Submitted by WB Kevin Schwab
